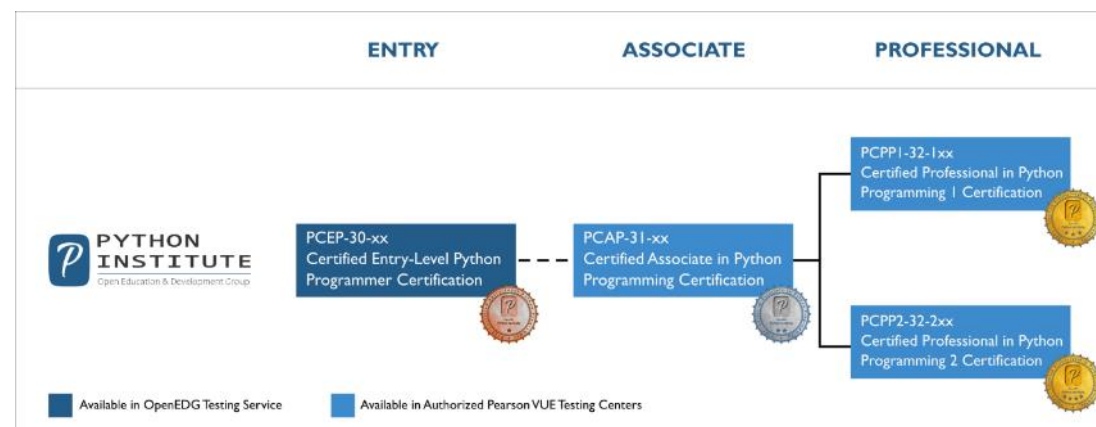
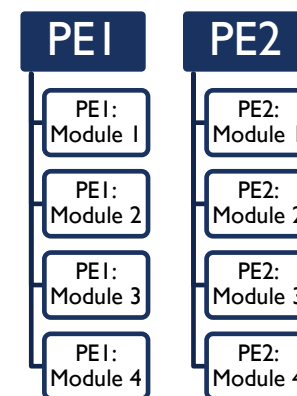
COURSE STRUCTURE

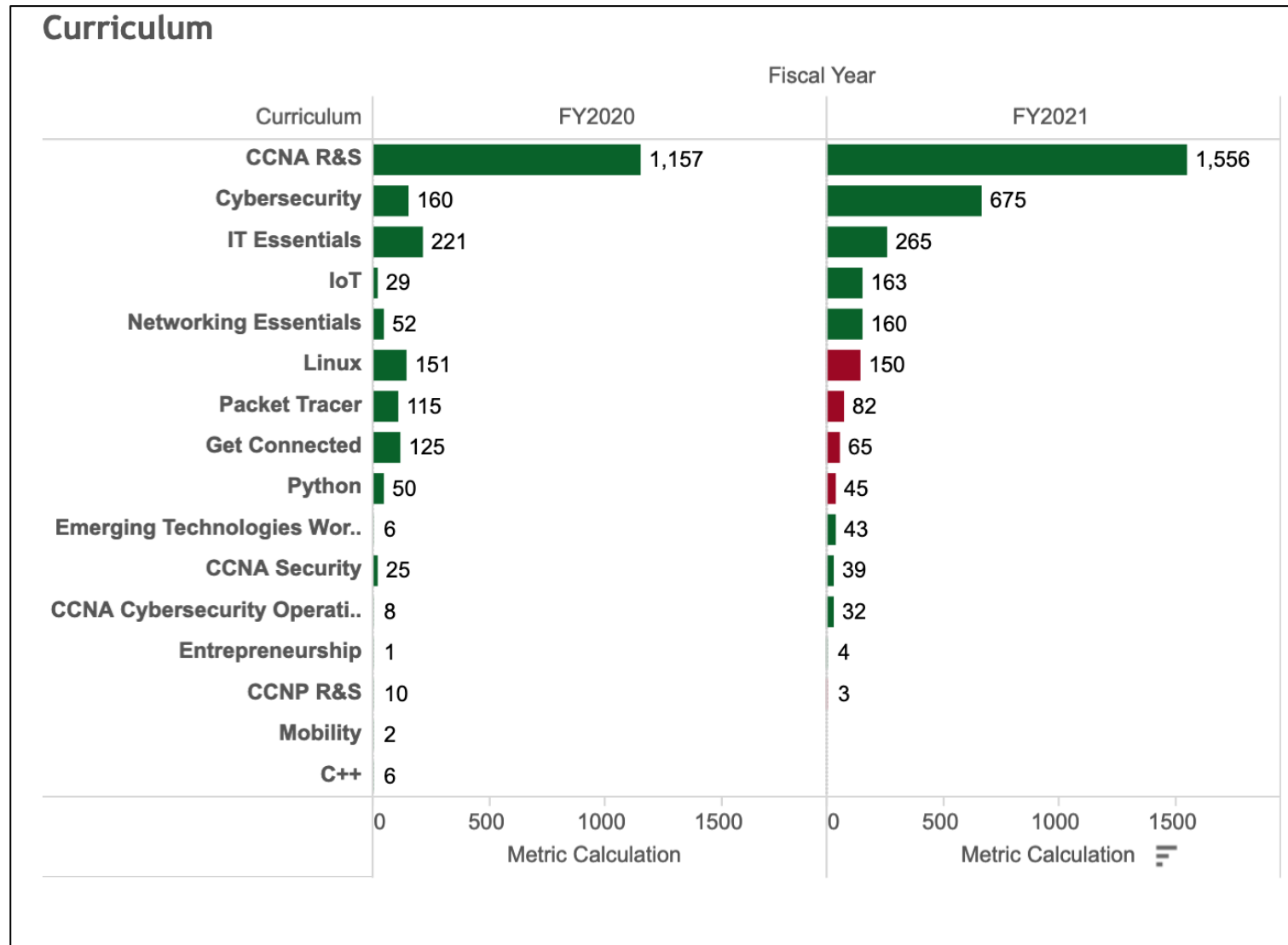

NetAcad Webex – Key Elements

- Eligibility: CCT instructors that have started a class on or after July 26th, 2020 without an existing Webex account linked to their NetAcad Instructor email address
- Full enterprise capabilities
- Including unlimited number of minutes, includes Meetings, Training and Events with **1,000** attendees per event.
- No dial-in/dial-out capabilities (VoIP enabled)
- Entirely managed by NetAcad. All instructor inquiries should be sent to the NetAcad helpdesk.



Signup for Webex for NetAcad

- The process for provisioning an account is being automated!
- Before the automated process is in place, we have just a few people provisioning over 9000 accounts in batches manually.
- Soon, an instructor can view their eligibility and request a license directly through their profile.
- NetAcad Support will help with any technical difficulties.
