#### REGIONAL PROGRAM OF STUDY CALCULATIONS FOR CTE INDICATORS



House Bill 773 (87R) added students who successfully complete a program of study in career and technical education (CTE) to the list of indicators that can be used to calculate college, career, and military readiness (CCMR). A local education agency (LEA) may offer any approved <u>statewide programs of study</u>. Autocoding is used to calculate the CTE indicators for participants (code 5), explorers (non-downgraded code E), concentrators (code 6), and completers (code 7).

<u>Regional programs of study</u> meet a specialized industry need within a particular region(s). Therefore, regional programs of study are approved for use in regions that apply and successfully show labor market demand. **CTE indicators of** students who are enrolled in regional programs of study are calculated based on their campus' address and associated region. The regional programs of study for the 2023-2024\* school year are:

- Printing and Imaging
- Retail Management
- Cosmetology and Personal Care Services
- Industrial Maintenance

- Geospatial Engineering and Land Surveying
- Aviation
- Drone
- Maritime

\*Regional programs of study will be updated on the website for the 2024-25 school year.

#### What does this mean for my LEA?

Independent School Districts (ISDs):

• Ensure the campus' physical address is correct in AskTED. ISD TED administrators can update their own campuses.

Charter Schools:

 Charter school administrators should request changes to the campus' physical address by submitting the <u>All-In-One Charter School Update Form</u> or emailing <u>CharterAskTED@tea.texas.gov</u>.

#### Why is it important to list the correct physical address of the school?

Each school's physical address will be used to link it to the region in which the school is located. Ensuring the correct physical address is listed in AskTED will facilitate the correct autocoding of CTE indicators for students who are enrolled in a regional program of study, potentially affecting CCMR.

  - Adjusted Eligible Equivalent Days is calculated as the lesser of the Eligible Equivalent Days or NUMBER-DAYS-TAUGHT (E0935). (Per student, campus, instructional track, reporting period and grade level)
  - TEA has determined that LEAs reported Eligible Equivalent days that were greater than the number of days taught.
  - LEAs are funded on the Adjusted Eligible Equivalent Days.

### **CURRENT KNOWN ISSUES**



- Issue: Based upon LEAs informing TEA of students being reported with incorrect CTE indicators, the CTE team has confirmed several charter school campuses are having their Regional Program of Study Concentrators (Code '6') and Completers (Code '7') incorrectly reverted to an Explorer (Code 'E'). It is also possible that some students' data are incorrectly coded as a '6' or '7' and should be an 'E', based on the physical location of the school.
- This may indicate the "ESC Geographic Region" field, used to determine if a campus is in an approved region, is adopting the charter school authorizer/district "ESC Geographic Region" value, instead of the ESC value, for the physical charter campus location.



### **CURRENT KNOWN ISSUES**



- Solution: Affected Charter LEAs will have a <u>Campus-level Geographic</u> <u>Region</u> assigned according to the charter campuses physical address.
- Campus-level Geographic Region will be implemented in a TEA application that will pass ESC region to AskTED using the physical street address located in AskTED for the charter campuses.
- The new Campus-level Geographic Region will not be visible to the LEA; however, it will be used when TEA processes the auto-calculated CTE indicators after PEIMS Summer First Submission, PEIMS Summer Resubmission, PEIMS Extended Year First Submission and PEIMS Extended Year Resubmission.

#### **APPLICATION UPDATES**



#### Legislative Update (HB1416) – Accelerated Instruction:

- HB 1416, passed during the 88th legislative session, amends Section 28.0211, Education Code related to accelerated and supplemental instruction for students. Each student that fails to achieve at least satisfactory performance on each assessment instrument administered under Section 39.023, Education Code must be provided supplemental instruction for no less than 15 hours or 30 hours for a student whose performance on the applicable assessment instrument was significantly below satisfactory, as defined by commissioner rule.
- The Texas Tutoring Supports division at the Texas Education Agency (TEA) has requested that local education agencies (LEAs) have a method to transfer the accelerated education plan developed for each student when the student transfers to a new LEA. Additionally, the division has requested that information be reported to TEA to monitor and evaluate the effectiveness of the accelerated instruction provided by each LEA.

### **APPLICATION UPDATES**



#### Legislative Update (HB 2209) – Rural Pathway Excellence Partnership

- HB 2209, passed during the 88th Legislative Regular Session, added Texas Education Code Section 29.912 for the Rural Pathway Excellence Partnership (R-PEP). This partnership allows rural school districts to enter into agreements with other districts to develop rural college and career pathway partnerships. The funding for the program comes from the Foundation School Program. The program area has requested a student-level indicator to determine which students participate in the R-PEP program. The indicator will be used to calculate the ADA allotment funding.
- During the October 17, 2023, ITF meeting, the committee approved a student levelindicator to indicate the students who participate in a Rural Pathway Excellence Partnership (R-PEP) program as outlined by HB 2209, passed during the 88th Legislative Regular Session. Since then, the program area has requested an additional data element be added to track the hours a student participates in the R-PEP program.
