- The right for your child to participate fully and equally in school
- The right to receive information about any activity, program, or service in a language you understand

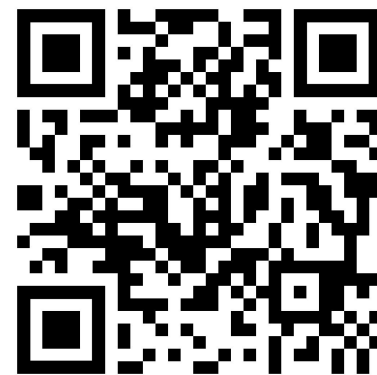

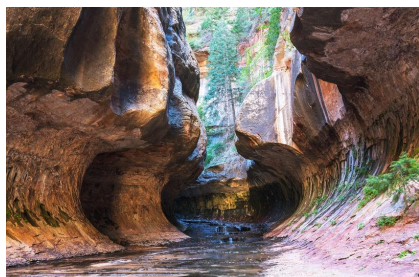

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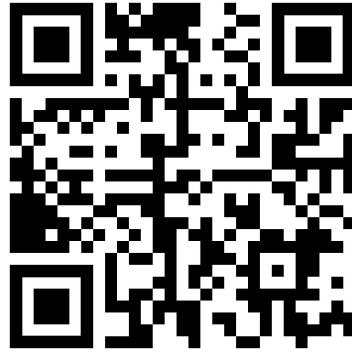
