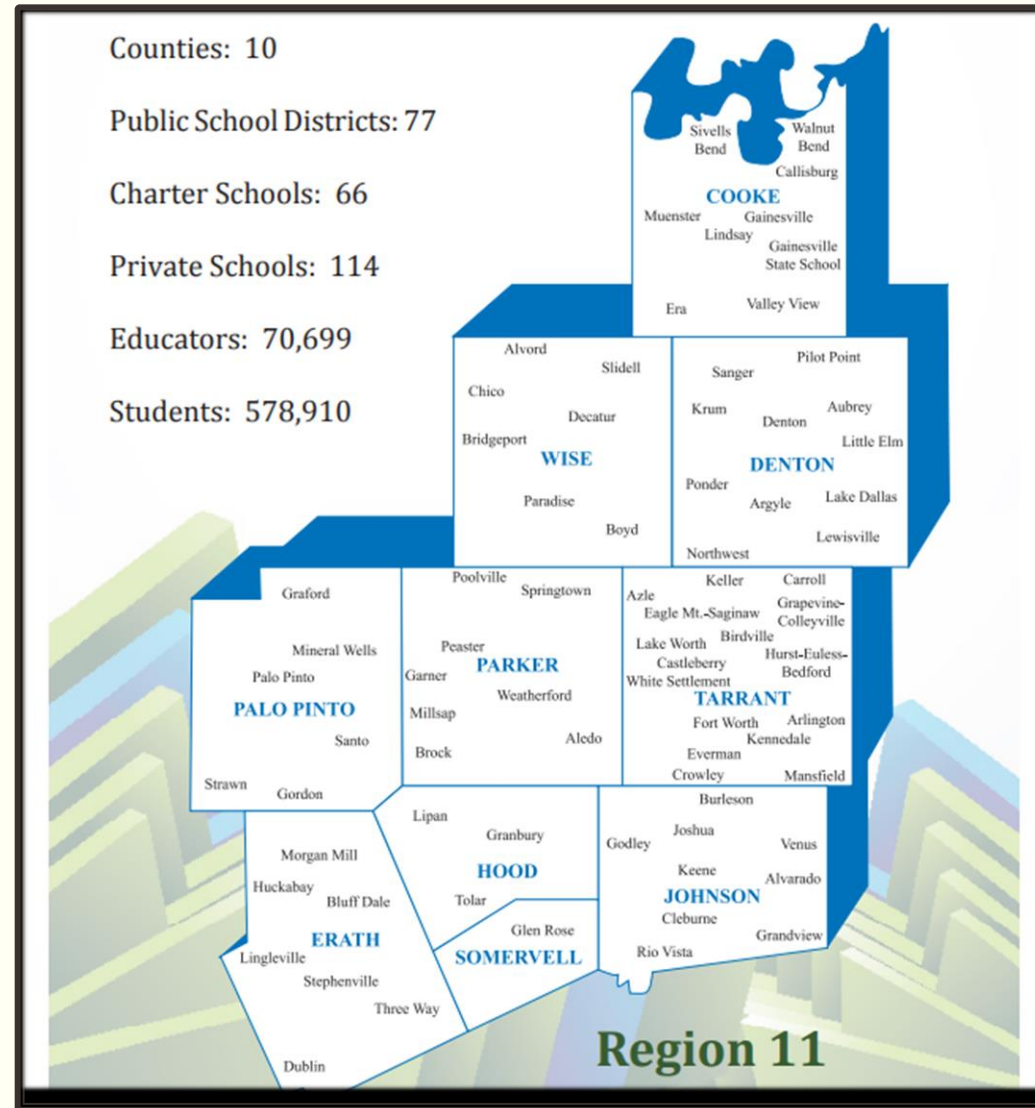

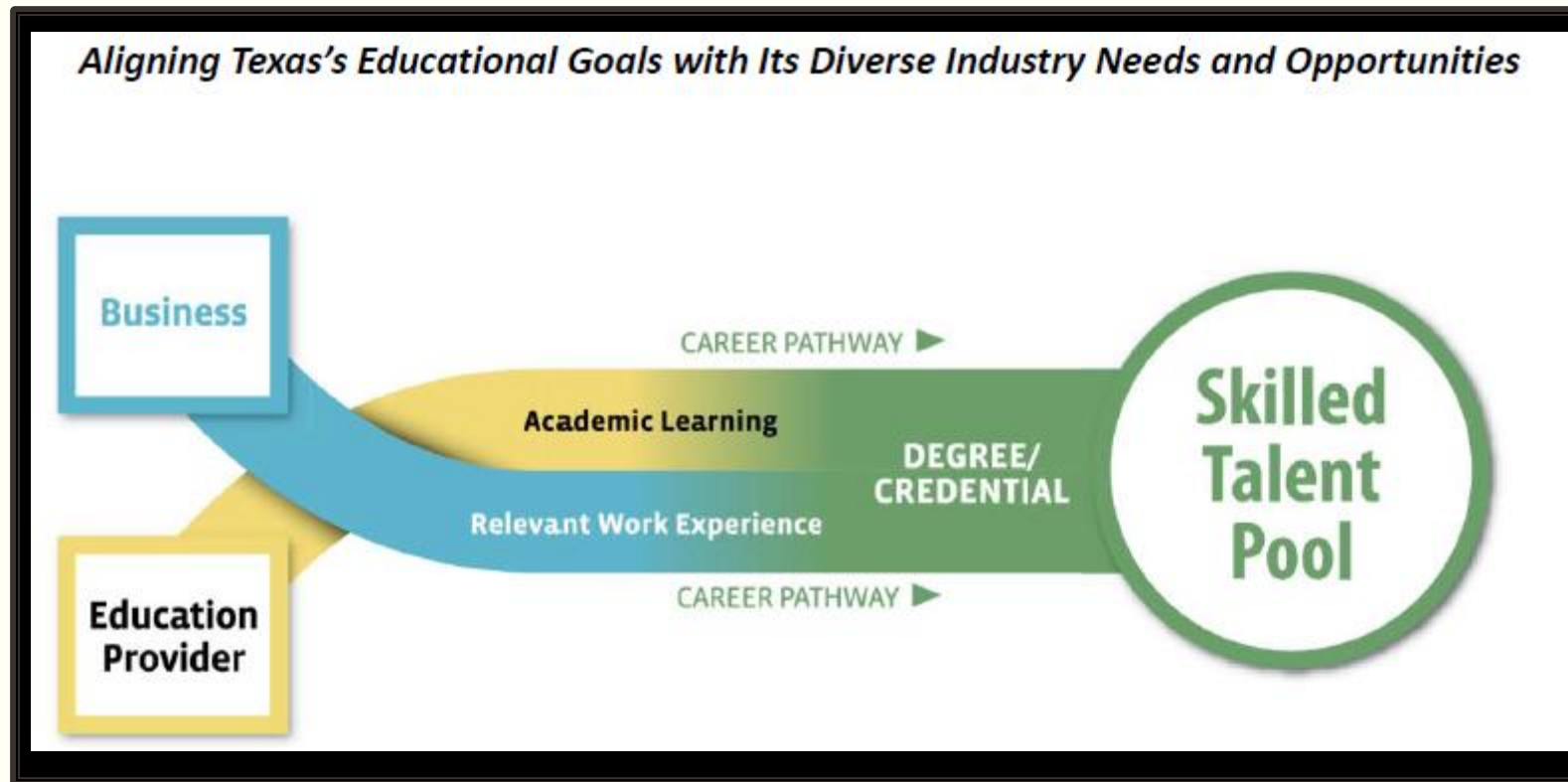

- Backwards-map from job knowledge and skill demand, through preparation (college, trade schools, certifications, etc.) to education and experience
- Triangulate LMI:
 - TWC projections, EMSI data, and State Boards Targeted Occupations
 - High demand (> 17% growth) and High Wage (> \$35,339 median salary) jobs
 - Ensure methodology is defensible and replicable at region and district level
- Vet the process with advisory councils and industry associations

 - May create a document with language to assist them
- Comment was due February 4th.
- *Comment period extended until Feb. 15th.*
